

## Applications for the Internationalization Grant at TUM School of Management

### Coverage

The Internationalization Grant supports international research activities of **external doctoral candidates** up to a **€ 1.600,00** reimbursement.

International research activities that can be supported are:

- Research stays abroad
- International conferences
- Doctoral courses and summer/winter schools

The following costs can be reimbursed (according to BayRGK):

- Travel expenses
- Course and conference fees

### Eligibility

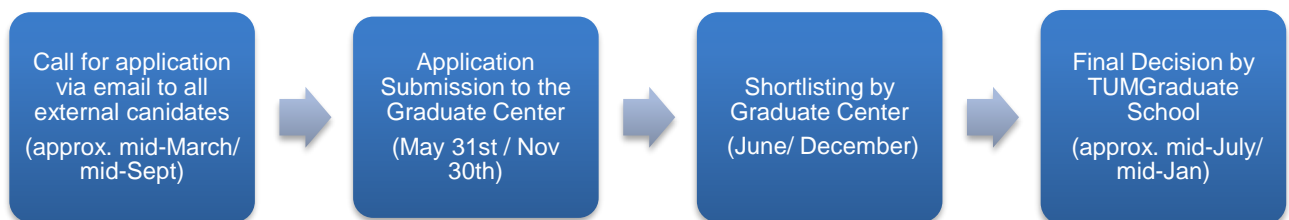
To be eligible to apply for the Internationalization Grant, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- External doctoral candidates, who are not employed at TUM.
- Have not received a traditional scholarship, fellowship or grant for their doctoral studies

### Procedure

TUM School of Management can support **one external candidate** per semester, by suggesting a short list to the TUM Graduate School, who will then take the final decision.

With regards to the respective semester, the timeline is as follows:



Applications cannot be submitted retroactively, only for upcoming international activity. The final decision will be made by the Graduate School and will be communicated according to the respective timeline. The next opportunity to apply will be in the following semester.

### Documents

The following documents must be submitted to the Graduate Center:

- Application form (to be found in the download center: <https://www.mgt.tum.de/download-center>)
- CV and publication list
- Support letter of your supervisor
- (if available) Letter of invitation from the host institution/ Summer School program or similar/ Conference program including confirmation of acceptance of paper, etc.
